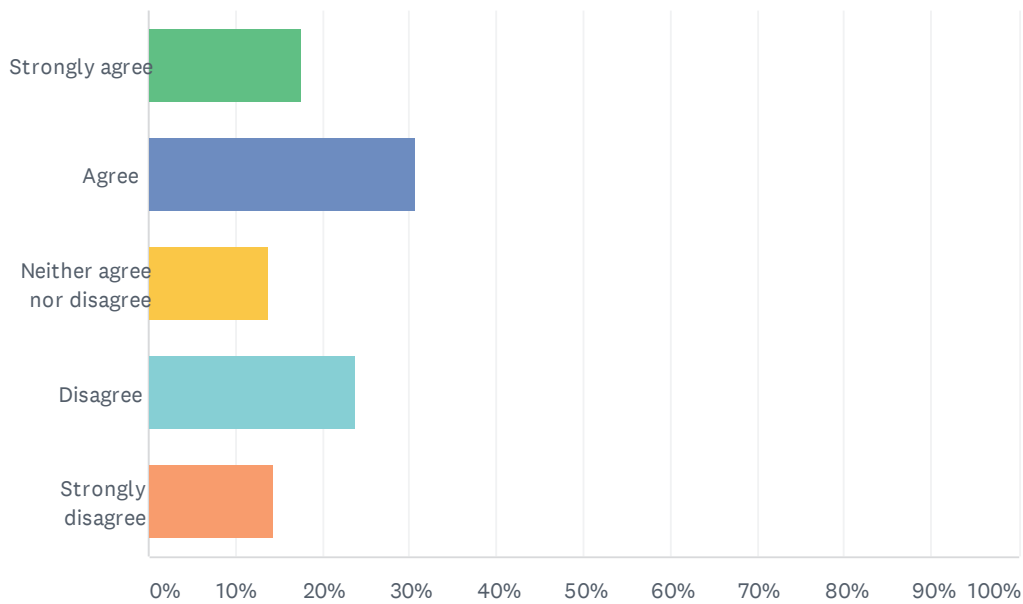


## Q1 Our Crisis Response Plan (CRP) was activated before COVID-19 cases arrived at our facility.

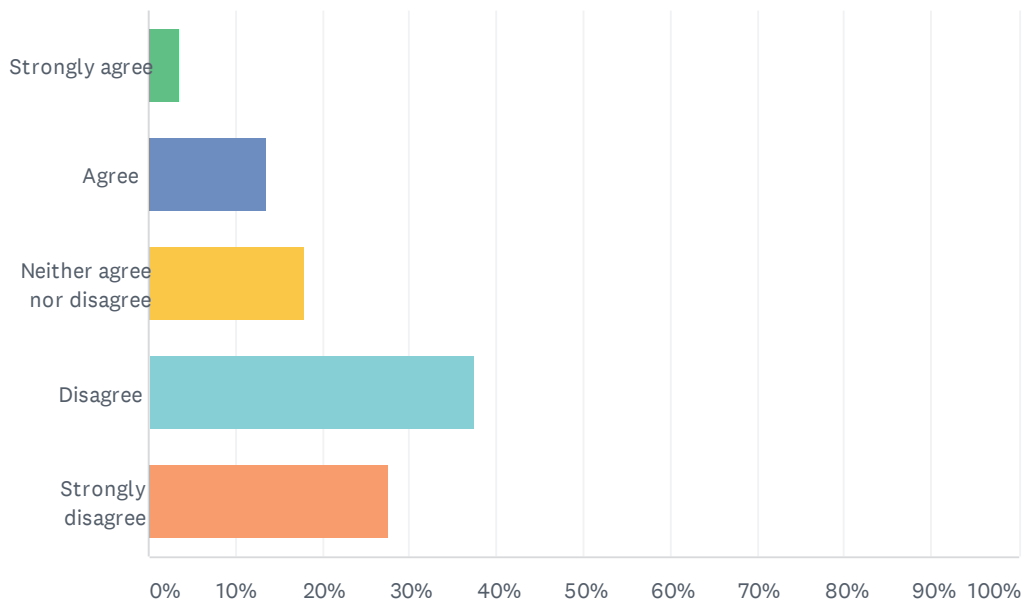

## Q2 Our previous training for possible pandemics helped prepare our staff for the COVID-19 pandemic.

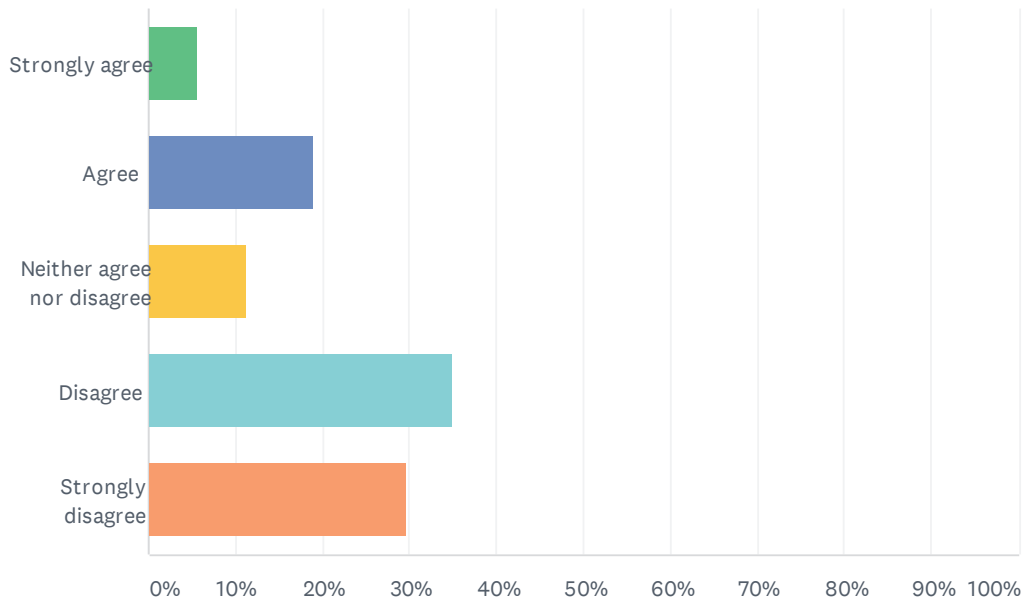

### Q3 Our supply of PPE, test kits, and ventilators was adequate, within the first weeks of the pandemic, for protection of staff and treating patients.

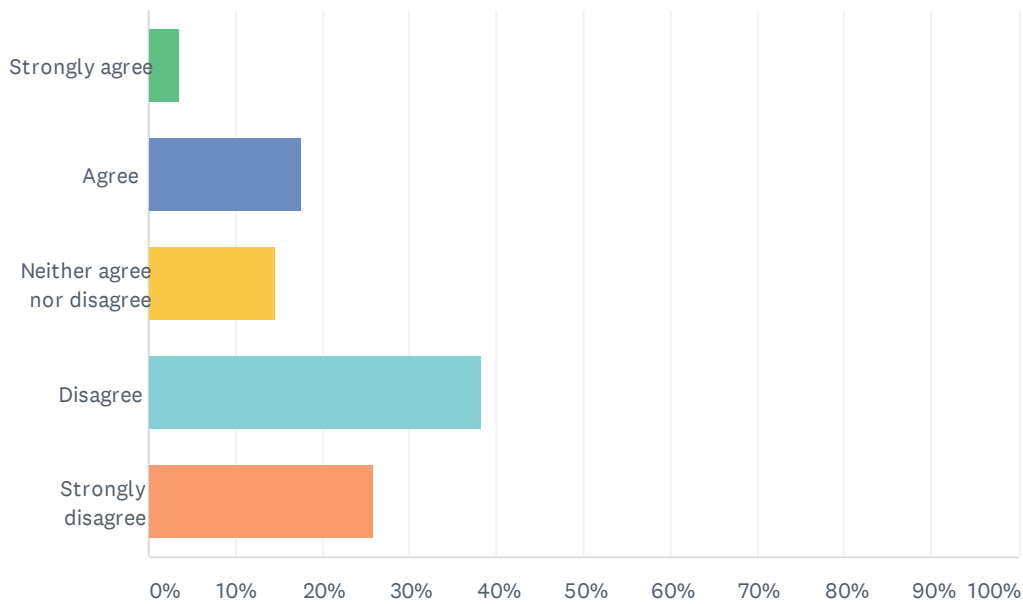

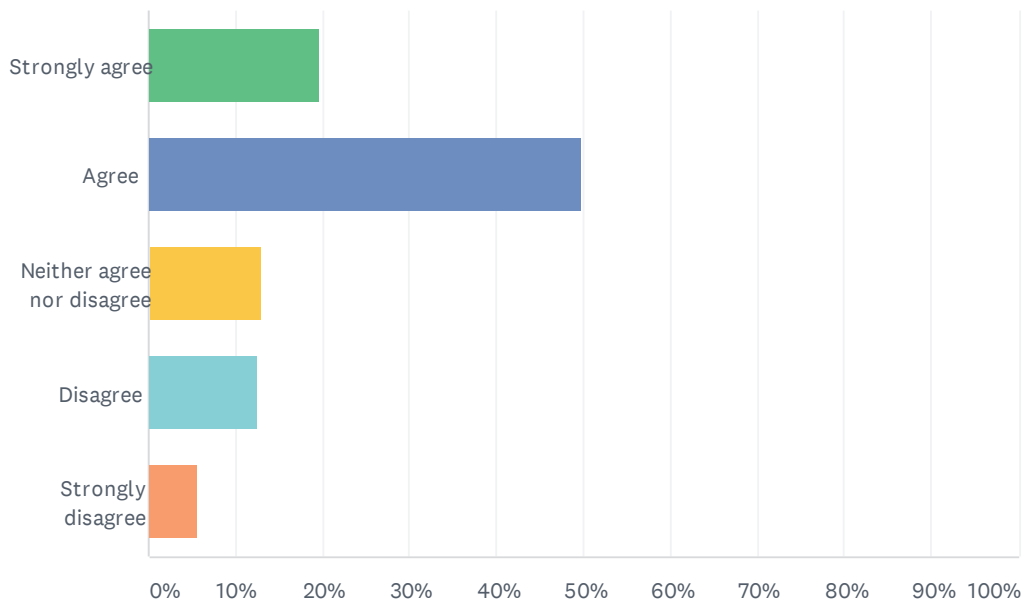

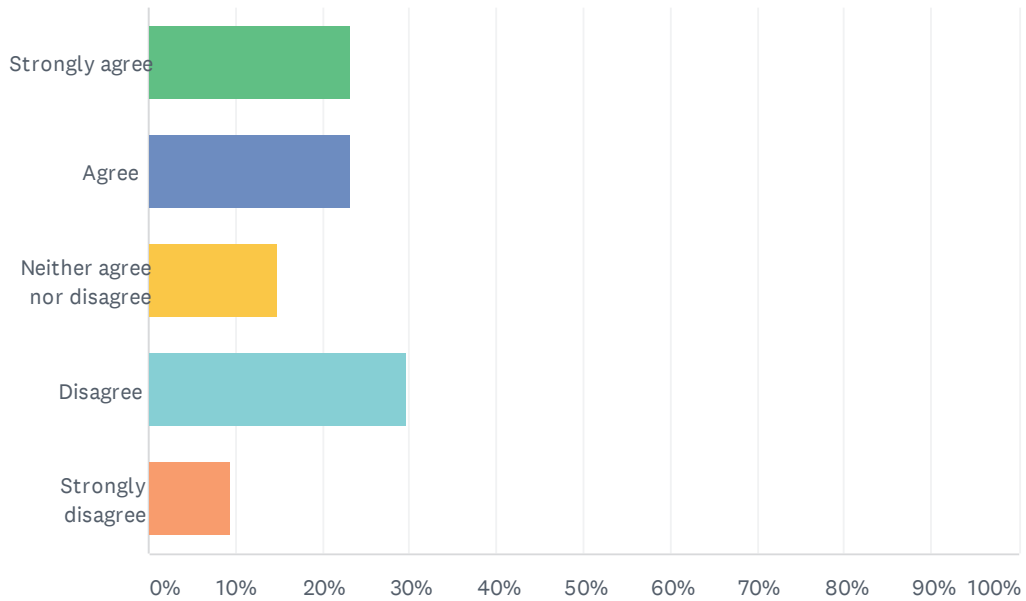

## Q6 My perception is that my facility has a shortage of nurses.

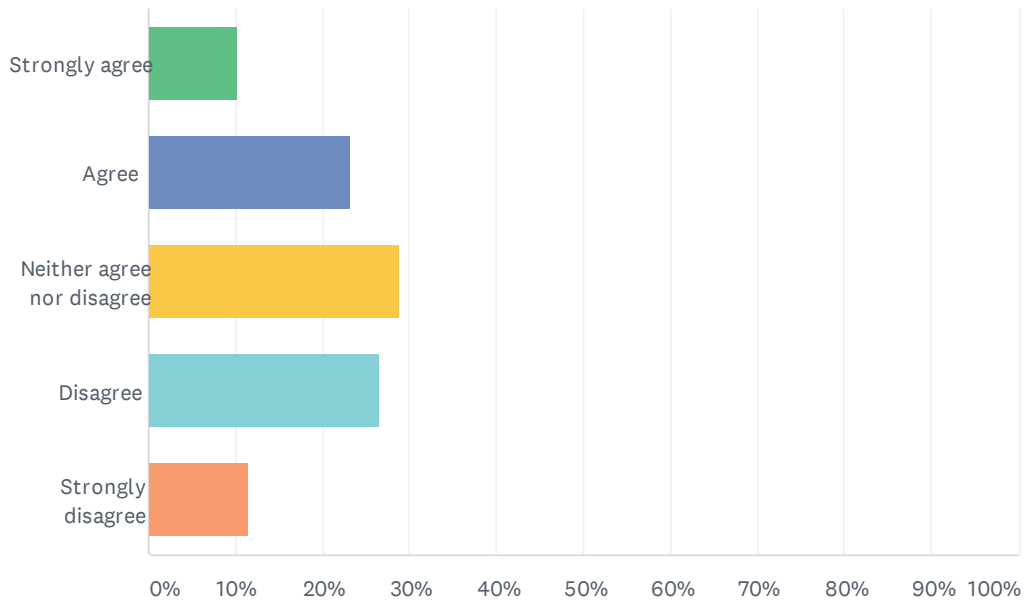

## Q7 We need retired nurses and new grads to fill needs in certain practice areas.

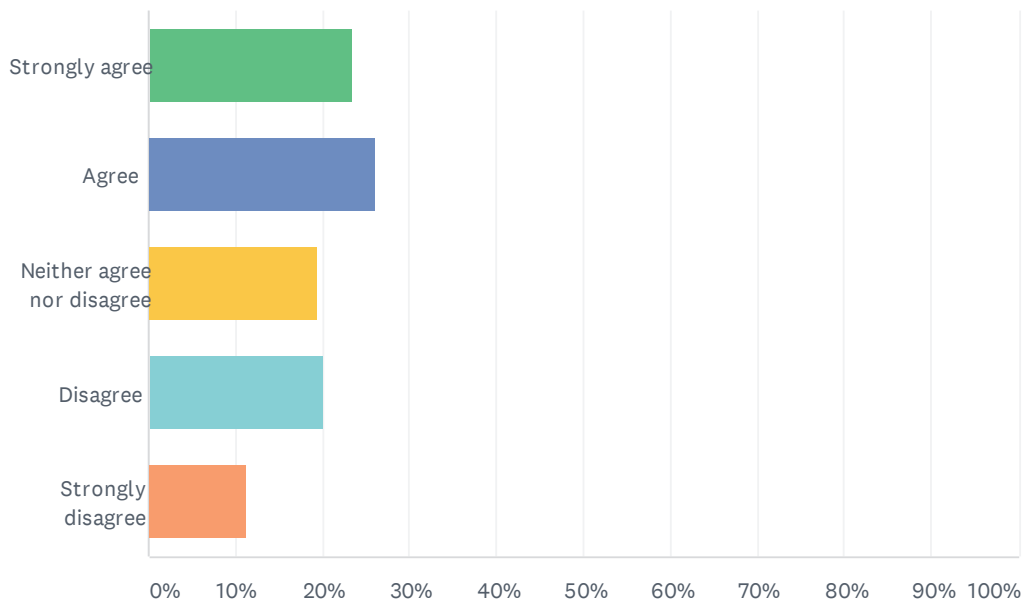

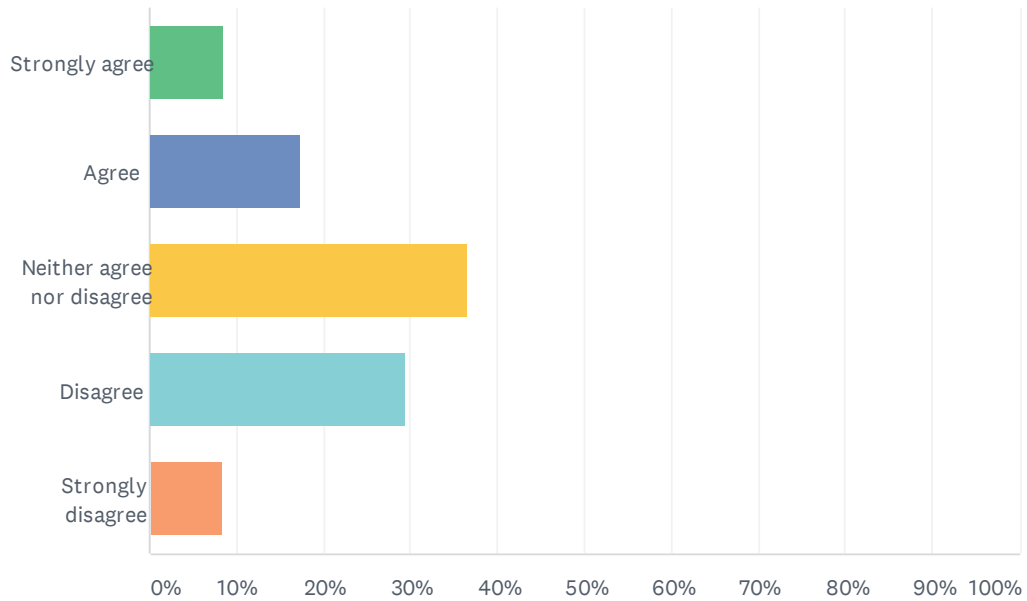

## Q9 Our emergency department has been overwhelmed.

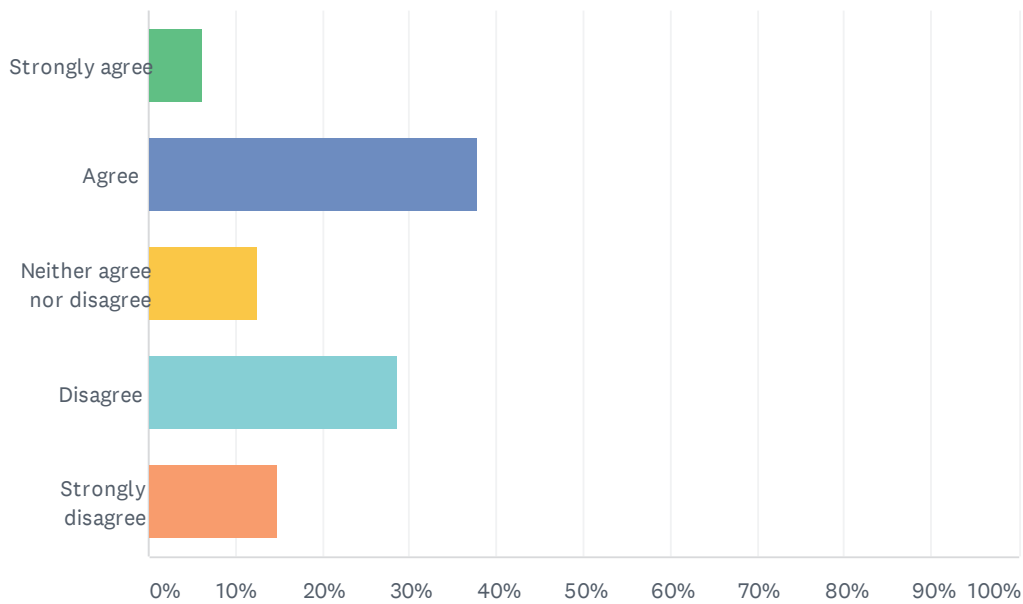

### Q10 I have been able to maintain a reasonable amount of self care, diet, exercise, relaxation and sleep.

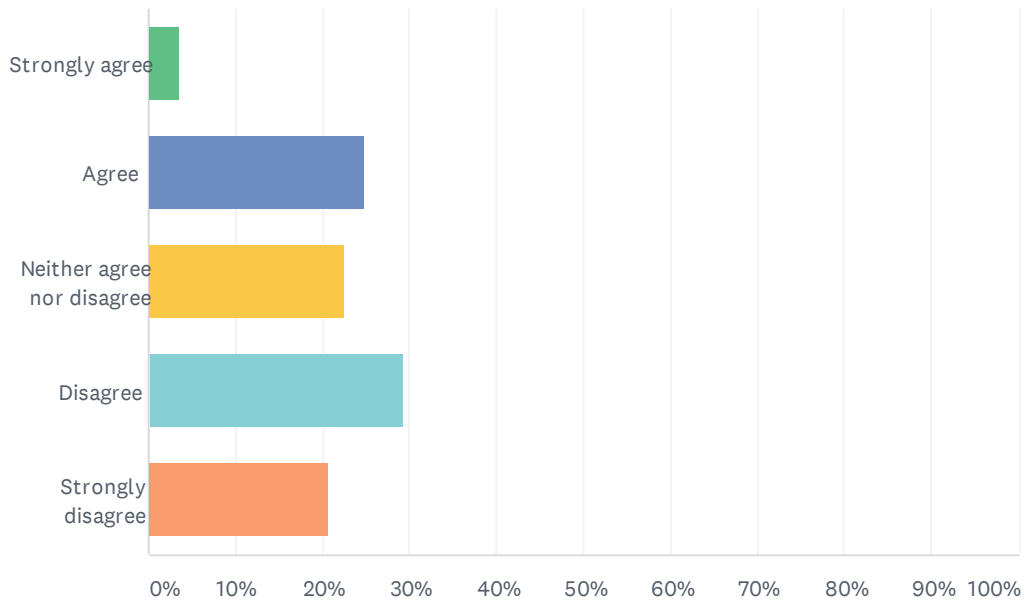

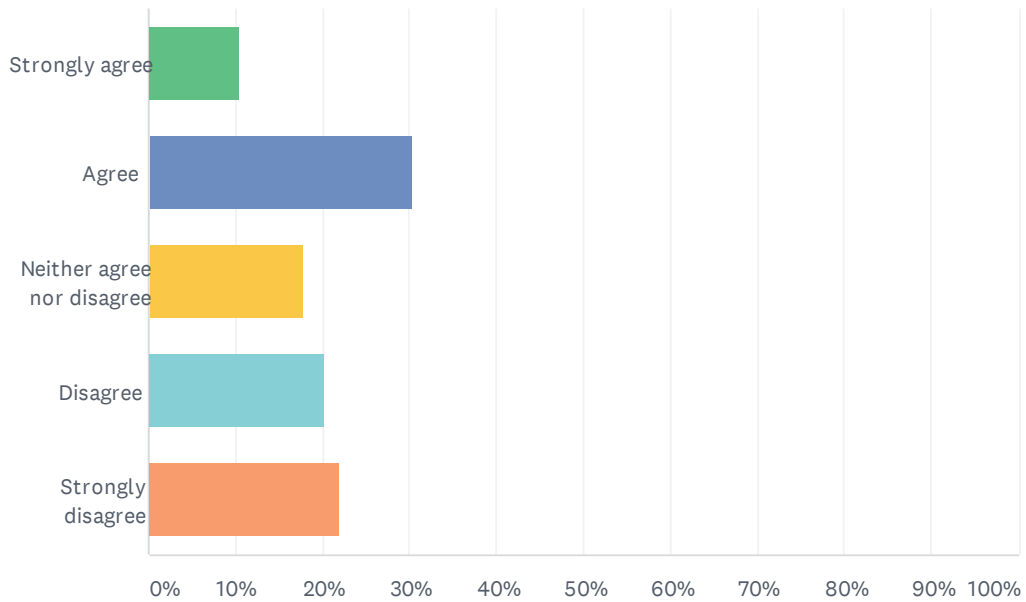
